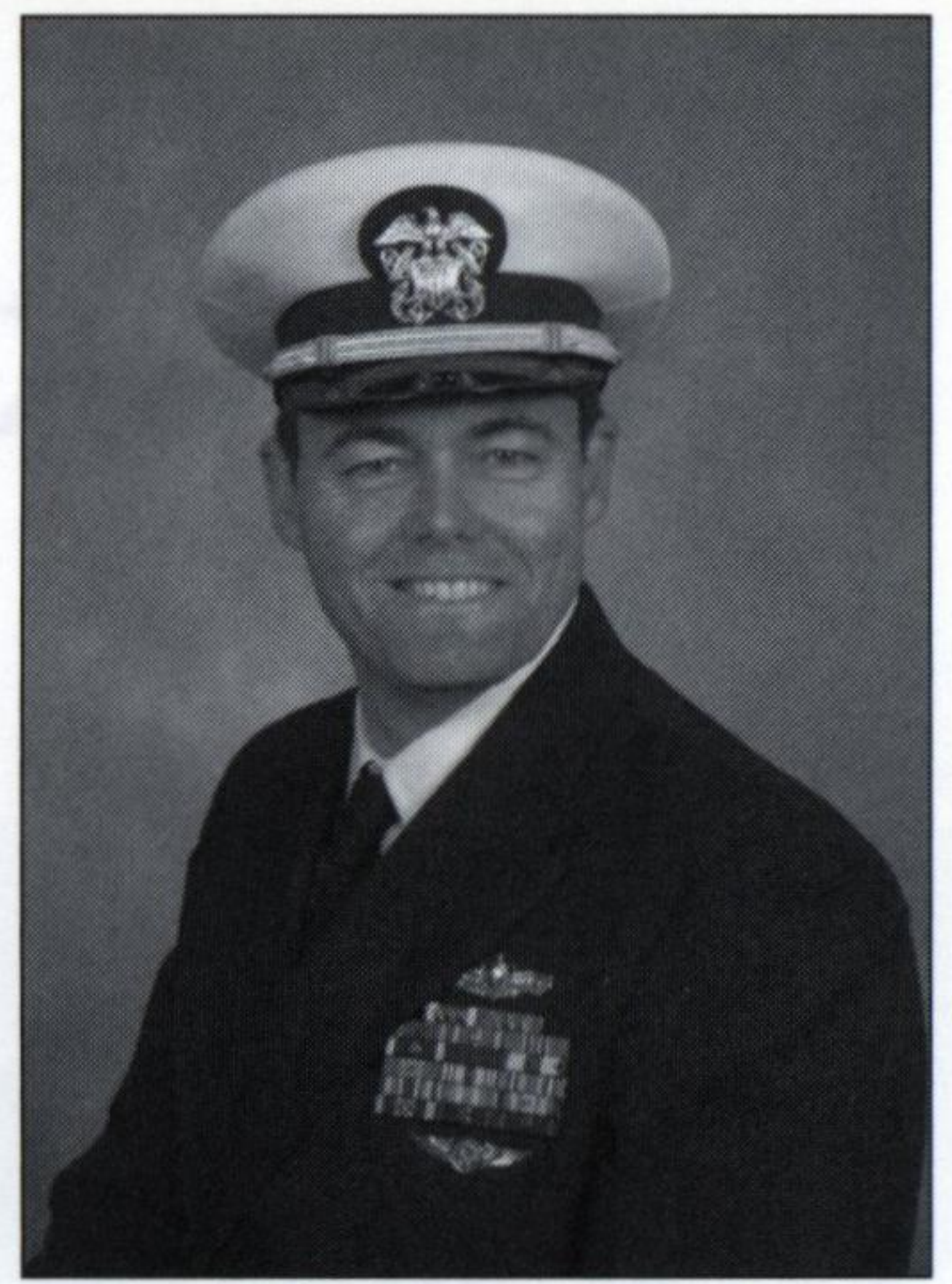


# Executive Department
