

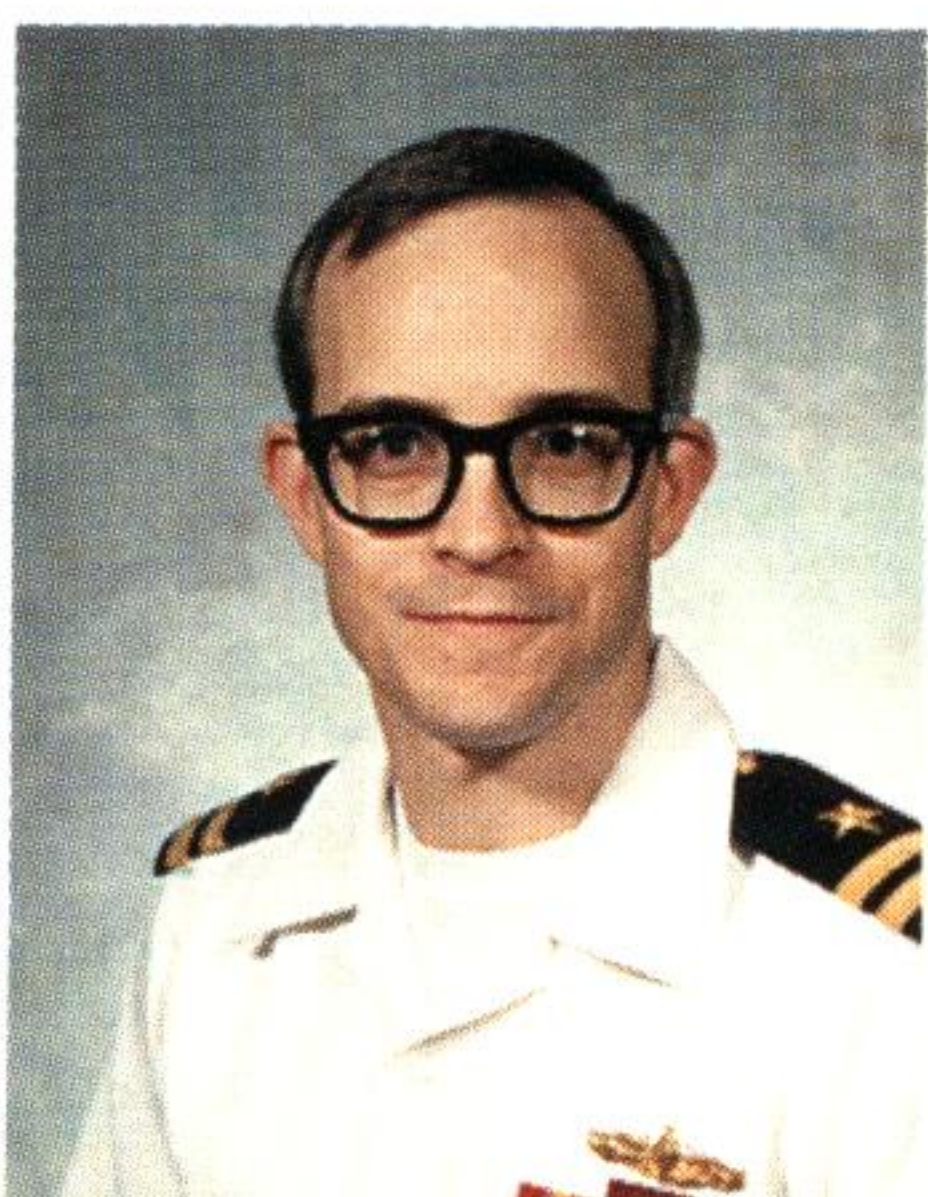
M DIVISION

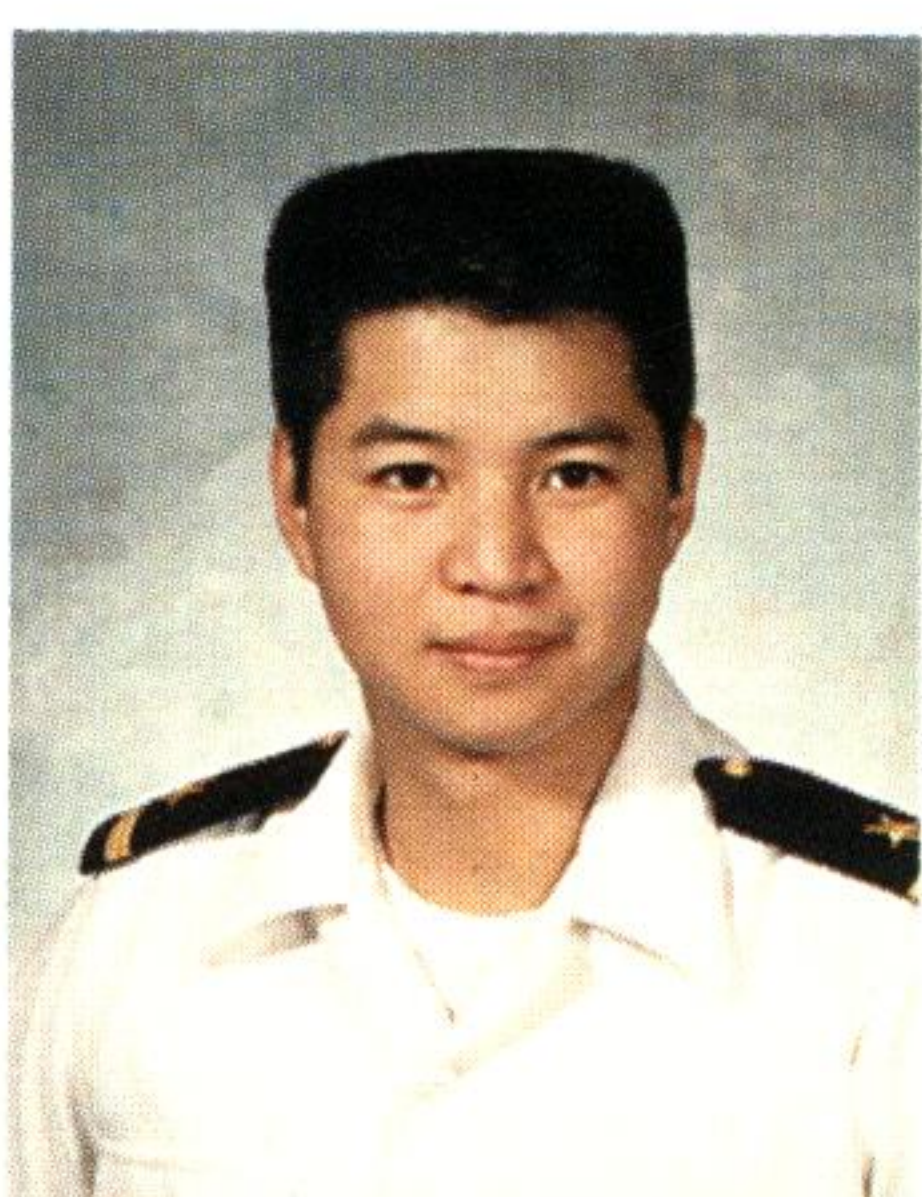
*"For there's not much that men can do, that these men haven't done
