



Captain R. R. FERRIS
Executive Officer of Troops

Captain R. R. FERRIS was born 2 December 1945 in Alam, Georgia. After graduation from high school he joined the United States Army in June 1964. After boot camp at Fort Ord, California, Captain Ferris saw duty in West Germany as a Communicator Specialist and in Vietnam as a Company RTO and grenadier.

Captain Ferris graduated from the Citadel in Charleston, South Carolina in May 1974 and reported to OCS on 9 June 1974 as an Officer Candidate in the 88th OCS, Quantice, Virginia.

Upon being commissioned and additional schooling at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, he was assigned to Battery B 1st Battalion, as a forward observer and later became the Executive Officer of Battery's "A" and "C" in the 1st Bn 10th Marine, and the Commanding Officer of HQ Battery 12th Marine. Upon returning to the United States in December 1978 Captain Ferris was assigned as a student to the Motor Transport School, Camp Johnson. He then served as the Commanding Officer of H & S Company, and Transport Company 8th Motor Transport Bn 2nd FSSG prior to being presently assigned as the Executive Officer of MSG 34.
